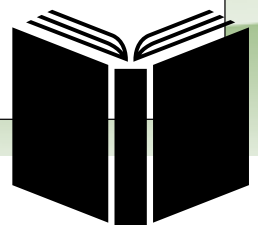
This week the Grade 2 class walked around only a small section of the school and collected a whole bag of rubbish.
