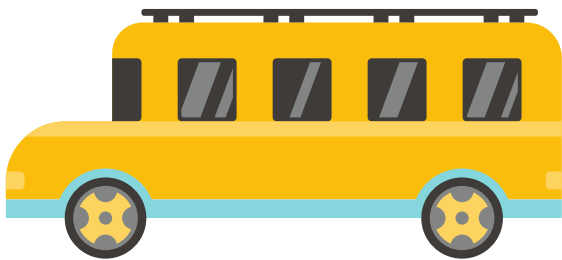

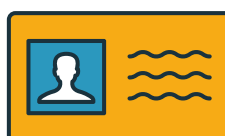
- FEES - Term 1 fees are due now

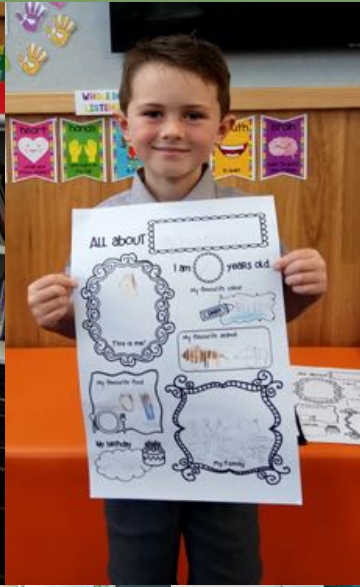
