A message from Mrs Lincolne

Imagine that you want a glass of water and you just stand in the kitchen waiting for it to appear without asking a person nearby to get you one. Or consider that you have lost your wallet and you just stand in one spot, waiting for it to reappear. And what if you go to visit a neighbour, and just stand at the front door without knocking, hoping the door will open by itself. None of these scenarios make sense. They require some sort of action on your part.

In the Bible we read about asking, seeking and knocking in Matthew 7, and on the surface it seems that God will give us whatever we want. But what it is really saying is this; to receive something, **ask**; to find something, **seek**; and to get the door opened, **knock**! So if you see others who have received, or have found or have had the door opened to them, it means they have been **asking**, **seeking** or **knocking** in the first place. Things won't just land in our lap, it requires faith in action on our part. Jesus says this, "For everyone who asks receives; the one who seeks finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened."


CARTOON WORKSHOP
