A message by the school Principal - Mrs Lincolne

Imagine you were born in 1900. When you're 14, World War I begins and ends when you're 18 years old, with 22 million dead. Shortly after, a global pandemic called 'the Spanish flu', kills 50 million people worldwide. You come out alive and free. You are now 20 years old. Then, at 29, you survive the global economic crisis that started with the collapse of the New York Stock Exchange, causing inflation, unemployment and hunger worldwide. At 33, the nazis come to power in Germany and you turn 39 when World War II starts. When it ends, you're 45. During the Holocaust 6 million Jews die. There will be over 60 million deaths in total. When you're 52, the Korean War begins. At age 64, the Vietnam War begins and ends at age 75.

A child born in 1990 thinks their grandparents have no idea how difficult life is, but they have survived several wars and disasters. A child born in 2000 thinks it's the end of the world when an Amazon package takes over three days to arrive or when they don't get more than 15 likes for the photo posted on Facebook or Instagram. Many of us live comfortably as Australians, have access to pretty much anything and often have more than we need. We have electricity, phones, cars, food, hot water, and a roof over our heads. But it seems people still want to complain about something or everything. Our parents, grandparents and great grandparents survived far more disastrous circumstances and never lost the joy of living.

Stop and thank God today, for putting you here at this time and not somewhere else. Smile at someone, encourage others, take a moment to watch the sunset, smell the flowers, give a hug, send a meal. And just stop complaining and instead be grateful and be thankful, and imagine what a different world it would be!!


